

“Just as humans cannot live without water, Christians cannot imagine living without the Word of God. Water and the Word go hand in hand as we strive to live as faithful followers of Jesus. This Bible study turns to some of the water stories and images in the Bible to enable us to learn more about God and how God would have us live our lives. The study also draws our attention to the power of water, its potential, and its effects on our lives and culture. We are invited to remember that water is precious and that clean water is unavailable to millions of people. Water and Word work together to quench the thirsts of our bodies and our souls” (*Come to the Waters*, Introduction, p. 5).

Each of the study’s nine lessons includes one or more Bible passages and a primary theological theme or issue. The titles and themes are: 1. Birthing Waters—Creation; 2. Life-giving Water—Baptism; 3. Absence of Water—Thirst and Longing; 4. Dangerous Waters—God’s Deliverance; 5. Stormy Water—Faith; 6. Waters of Justice and Righteousness—Justice; 7. Streams of Mercy—Forgiveness; 8. The Hospitality of Living Water—Compassion; 9. River of Life—Hope.
