## What is the theme of the 2018 Churchwide Gathering?

The theme is "Arise, shine, your light has come!" based on Isaiah 60:1.

#### When is the 2018 Churchwide Gathering?

The Gathering begins on Thursday, August 2, 2018, and concludes on Sunday, August 5, 2018.

## Where will this Gathering be held?

The Gathering will be held all under one roof at the Galt House in Louisville, Kentucky. Optional tours and events will visit local Presbyterian, mission-focused and cultural sites, but there's more than enough planned in the Galt House to keep you busy for the whole Gathering!

#### Who attends the Gathering?

Christian women (and a few men and children!) from across the country and around the world come together for this triennial event. Past Gatherings have included people of all ages and from more than 20 countries.

#### What happens at the Gathering?

Lots! Join in worship—enjoying uplifting music and gifted preachers—with sisters in faith from around the country and the world. Find inspiration in the plenary (large group) sessions, which highlight everything from Bible study to mission projects. Learn about your areas of passion and key issues in the world today through educational opportunities (forums and workshops) led by inspiring speakers. Get excited about the future of Presbyterian Women at the Business Meeting, where PW's 2018–2021 leaders will be elected, a budget will be finalized and programmatic emphases will be chosen. Witness the installation of the newly elected leaders of PW's 2018–2021 Churchwide Coordinating Team. Visit the many exhibits. Shop in the marketplace and bookstore. Take in some of the interesting and fun Louisville sights.

#### How much will the Gathering cost?

Full registration is \$425. Hotel, travel and some meals are additional.

#### Is there a discount if I only attend part of the Gathering?

Daily registration is \$125 per day.

## What hotel accommodations are available?

Housing and programming are all under one roof at the Galt House. Rooms start at \$144 per night; suites start at \$159 per night, for one to four persons per room, plus tax. These discounted rates will apply three nights before and after the Gathering.

#### Are transportation services available?

#### Are scholarships available?

A limited number of leadership development grants will be available to help with Gathering costs. # When should voting representatives be available for the Business Meeting?

The Business Meeting will begin Wednesday, August 1, at 7 PM and will conclude by 5 PM on August 2. Voting representatives travel on August 1.

The 2018 Gathering is an opportunity to "arise and shine," reflecting on the healing, prophetic, compassionate Light of the world. "Arise, shine, your light has come!" invites us to explore possibility, growth and radiance, empowered by God.



# How To Spread the Word

We need your help to bring together Presbyterian women for the fun, nurture, education, leadership development, Bible study and so much more that makes up the Gathering! Word of mouth is the best way to encourage others to attend, so share your enthusiasm and share it often!

Use and adapt the following suggestions and resources to promote the Gathering. Customize them with any information that will appeal to your audience.

Include the dates, location and Gathering web address in each and every one of your promotions. And don't forget that you can add the logo to any of your communications—see the art reproduction page or visit www.presbyterianwomen.org/gathering.

This Gathering web page will also have the most up-to-date details to include in your Gathering promotions. Visit often!

## Say It!

- 1. Tell your friends that you are going to the Gathering. If you have attended a Gathering before, tell them about your experience; if you haven't, encourage them to go on the adventure *with* you!
- 2. Invite five friends to go to the Gathering. Make it a point to say "Would you think about joining me at the Gathering?" to just five women you think may be interested—a newly retired woman, a longtime friend who always looks through your Gathering souvenirs, a young woman who's new to PW!
- 3. Make announcements at PW and church meetings about the Gathering. Be sure to share the date, location, theme, cost and your personal testament about why you attend the Gathering. Urge people to talk with you if they have questions.
- 4. Recruit your pastor to help spread the news. Provide her or him with basic information, and make sure s/he knows who is the contact person in your church for additional information.

## Act It Out!

- Don't be skit-ish! Recruit two friends to help you (or three friends, if you have stage fright!) perform the skit on page 22 at meetings to promote attending the Gathering.
- 6. Develop your own skit to promote the Gathering. (And send it to Carissa Herold, carissa.herold@pcusa.org, so she can share it with other dramatists!)

## Write It!

- Send notes to five friends, inviting them to attend the Gathering. Download the Gathering logo (from www.presbyterianwomen.org/gathering) to add to your stationery, or order PW logo notecards (PWR01010a; \$9 plus shipping for a package of 25) or postcards (PWR01011a; \$4 plus shipping for a package of 50). - 8. Write an article for your church newsletter about why the Gathering is important. Talk about your favorite events and programs at the Gathering, friends made or church/PW group work that began from inspiration at the Gathering. Be sure to include the Gathering website (www.presbyterianwomen.org/gathering) and the dates and location for the Gathering. Send copies to your presbytery and synod office, and let them know they can use the copy in their newsletters! (Please also email a copy to yvonne.hileman@pcusa.org; PW may use your story for promotions, newsletters or blogs.)
- 9. Send a note to women whom you know through PW. (See p. 9 for a sample note.) And don't stop with women in your congregation; look for other familiar names in your presbytery and synod directories.
- 10. Write a news release for your local newspaper, radio station and cable talk show host. Use information from this packet, and provide the names of local women who will be attending the Gathering.

## Pass It Out!

- 11. Provide fliers at every meeting you attend—in your circle, church, presbytery and synod. A flier is included in this packet and is downloadable from www.presbyterianwomen.org/gathering.
- 12. Make your friends Gathering fans! Using the template and instructions on pages 16 and 17, make a Gathering fan for everyone at your next circle, presbytery or synod meeting.
- 13. Give out Life Savers (candy) at meetings and explain how offerings taken at the Gathering help improve and save lives throughout the world.
- 14. Make copies of the puzzles on pages 14 and 15 for a fun way to promote Gathering attendance.

## **Decorate It!**

- 16. Create a bulletin board to promote the Gathering. Literally spell out "Attend the Gathering!" then add any resources, decoration, information or inspiration that you think will help. Tack up copies of the "Save the Date" magnet and flier, along with a way to get in touch with local attendees or the main contact for Gathering attendance in your congregation, presbytery or synod.
- 17. Use props to decorate a Gathering table or display case.
  - Interpret the "Arise, shine, your light has come!" theme with pictures of the many women who have committed to attending.
  - Louisville is known for the Kentucky Derby maybe you'd like to use the horse clip art (see the art reproduction sheet) on invitations or promotions? Stuffed or ceramic horses at your next circle, presbytery or synod gathering, holding signs

encouraging Gathering attendance?




## Announcement to speak and print\*

# **Celebrating 30 Years**


This Gathering promo pack offers lots of ways to promote the Gathering! Focus your promotion on whatever speaks to you and your group—


- the timeless appeal of Churchwide Gatherings,
- the 2018 Churchwide Gathering scripture, theme and logo,
- the playful mascot, encouraging you to gallop to the Gathering, and/or
- that 2018 marks 30 years of Presbyterian Women!

The first three angles appear throughout this packet, but here are a few ideas all about PW's 30th anniversary!

- 1. Throw a PW anniversary party with your circle!
- Plan to attend an even BIGGER celebration at the 2018 Churchwide Gathering—and invite your friends!
- 3. Explore fun and creative ideas related to the 30th anniversary theme.
  - Create a bulletin board display, themed PW: Celebrating 30 Years of Ministry and Mission! Let's take a stroll down Memory Lane, while planning a PW future! Add a construction paper "road" with highlights of PW during this 30-year journey. Use clippings from newsletters, highlights of mission projects, reflections, photos. For the future, show the road winding into the sunrise. The PW Purpose could be a prominent building or the rays of the sun!
  - Start a new memory time capsule. Ask everyone in your circle to bring in mementos or items that can be put into a time capsule (with an explanation, of course).
    Consider photos, favorite prayers, tickets to a Gathering, Bible study reflections. Make time to collect and discuss items regularly throughout 2018, then make plans to open the time capsule at a future date.
  - The Think You Know PW? posters (available as free downloads from www.presbyterianwomen.org) are a great way to celebrate what PW has meant, does now and makes possible for the future.

- The pearl is often considered the "gem" of note for 30th anniversary celebrations, at least in the west. A pearl-themed celebration (lots of white balloons!) might be a fun way to commemorate 30 years of PW. (You may want to explore the parable from Matthew 13:45: "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant in search of fine pearls; on finding one pearl of great value, he went and sold all that he had and bought it.")
- Share reflections on what PW has meant to you and your dreams for PW. Want to share widely? Email carissa.herold@pcusa.org.
- 5. Follow the Gathering Quest emails for more information and great ideas. Each Gathering Quest includes at least one question about PW history during these 30 years. If you are not already receiving emails from PW, email patricia.longfellow@pcusa.org and ask to be added to the email distribution list.
- Remember that a gift to the Mission Pledge, PW's annual fund, makes everything that PW does possible. To give, visit www.presbyterianwomen.org.
- 7. Order the PW History Exhibit Kit (item PWR15137) to learn more about the 200-plus years of Presbyterian women heritage, including PW's predecessor organizations and amazing individual women. 



## Materials

1 sheet of cardstock for each fan

1 sheet of printer paper for each fan

A handle for each fan (Paint stirrers work nicely.)

Spray adhesive

Scissors

## Instructions

- 1. Photocopy the fan graphic on page 16, making as many copies as you will make fans.
- 2. Following the instructions on the can of adhesive, spray the back side of the printout and attach it to the cardstock.
- 3. After you have attached the image to the cardstock, cut out the fan following the dotted line. (Cutting just inside of this line will give you a nice clean edge.)
- 4. Adjust your paint stirrer to the length you prefer and attach it with the spray adhesive.
- 5. Set fan aside and let the glue dry.




# Seed Packet Template

The seed packet template below is available for you to cut, fold and fill. Add something special such as sunflower seeds (edible or to plant), Skittles or M&Ms or other sweet treats, or another fun idea! Add your own words to the packets and share with your circle or coordinating team, at your gatherings or even Sunday school. And here's a short reflection to share with the lucky recipients of the seed packet.

The theme for the Gathering is "Arise, shine, your light has come!" based on Isaiah 60:1. The 2018 Gathering logo features these words and a bright yellow sunflower against a bright sky.

The sunflower is a perfect symbol for Presbyterian Women. Presbyterian Women, like sunflowers, live for the Light. In fact, sunflowers are known to "follow the sun," turning toward the light, a phenomenon known as heliotropism. Sunflowers are native to North America but can now be found all over the world. There are several types of sunflowers—some tall, others short—but all sunflowers are hardy and serve as a reminder of the light.





# Instructions for Fabric Sunflowers and Crocheted Sunflowers

Presbyterian Women Marilynn Collins and Joyce Booth offered their considerable expertise, creating the following instructions for making amazing fabric and crocheted sunflowers, respectively.

Use the following guides to make a field of sunflowers for you and your sisters! Wear them on your lapels, tag them to your totes, dress up your hats, make earrings and necklaces. Let your imagination transform the world from blah to sunflower special!

## Crocheted Sunflower

## Supplies

- Worsted weight yarn in yellow
- Crochet hook, size G
- 3/4" button
- Scissors


## Steps

- 1. CH 4, join with SL ST to first CH to form ring.
- 2. 6 SC in ring. Join with SL ST to 1st SC.
- 3. 2 SC in each SC around (12 SC).
- 4. In next SC (SL ST, CH 2, DC, CH 3, SL ST in 3rd CH from hook, DC, CH 2, SL ST). You've finished one petal!
- 5. Skip next SC and repeat between ( ) for five more petals.
- 6. SL ST in same stitch as first petal and fasten off.
- 7. Attach button in your preferred manner (glue, thread or yarn).





# **Fabric Sunflower Templates**





# **Fabric Sunflower**

Supplies (Makes One)

- Scissors
- Erasable marker or pencil
- Ruler or tape measure
- Fabric in two complementary colors (sunflower-patterned or -colored)
  - o Fabric 1: 8.5" x 4.25" piece
  - o Fabric 2: 7" x 3.5" piece
- Thread, complementary color
- Double-sided interfacing—weight of your choice

**Note:** I used "Steam-a-seam 2" by the Warm Company. If you choose a very thick interfacing, you only need half the length of the fabric pieces.

- o Piece 1, cut to same 8.5" x 4.25" measurements as Fabric 1
- o Piece 2: cut to same 7" x 3.5" measurements as Fabric 2
- Button or pin (perhaps a PW pin!) for center of flower
- Cardboard or vinyl, optional

## Directions

- 1. Cut out the two pattern pieces from page 20. Copy onto cardboard or vinyl, if you plan to reuse.
- 2. Iron the uncovered side of the interfacing onto the fabric strip with a dry iron, using the heat listed on the interfacing instructions. (Photo 1)
- 3. Remove the interfacing paper. Fold the fabric and the interfacing in half and iron again.
- 4. Using the pattern, center the flower pieces on each square of fabric and draw around the petals with an erasable marker or pencil. Mark the center of each flower so that the layers can be aligned easily when completed.
- 5. Stitch around each outline using a complementary-colored thread with a very narrow zigzag or buttonhole stitch. (Photo 2)
- 6. Cut around petals very carefully so you do not accidentally clip any of the stitching threads. (Photo 3)
- 7. Layer the two sets of petals, offsetting the points. Sew short lines from the center so the petals stay in place. (Photo 4)
- 8. Complete the flower with a PW pin (or pin of your choice) through the center. (Photo 5)
- **Note:** The interfacing will gum up your sewing machine needle and, eventually, the tension. If you are making more than one sunflower, wipe the needle with alcohol between flowers, and before beginning a different project.

## Actors

- 3 scripted actors on stage—PW1, PW2, PW3
- 3 actors planted in audience—Red Card Plant, Blue Card Plant, Green Card Plant

## Costumes/props

- Shiny clothing for the Three Wise PW—shiny cloth, aluminum foil, battery operated twinkle lights, etc.
- Three clue cards; mount each clue on red, blue or green paper (as indicated in script)

## The Three Wise PW enter the stage, humming the tune of "We Three Kings."

- PW1: (*Talking to the audience*) We are searching for our light. Can you help us?
- PW2: We each had a dream and were told, "Arise!"
- PW3: "Shine!"
- PW1: "Your light has come!"
- PW2: We arose and left our homes, searching. And because we are women, we are not afraid to ask directions.
- PW3: We made ourselves shine. (Indicate shiny outfits.)
- PW1: But we can't find our light.
- PW2: We did have a clue saying "Are you REaDy?" (*emphasize* "*red*") So we think we should look for something red.
- PW3: Has anyone seen anything red that might be a clue for us?

- PW1: (Rolling eyes) Anyone have a blue clue for us?
