• The D.I.A.P.E.R. Project (Diapering Infants and Providing Emergency Resources), Charlestown, Indiana

This ministry provides diapers, nutritious food and first-aid supplies to families (with infants or small children) who are struggling financially.

• Kentucky Refugee Ministries, Inc. (KRM), Louisville, Kentucky

KRM, established with the assistance of Presbyterian Women, provides resettlement services to refugees through faith- and agencybased co-sponsorship. KRM connects refugees with community resources and opportunities that promote self-sufficiency and successful integration into the community.

• Lily's Place, Huntington, West Virginia

Lily's Place provides medical care to infants suffering from neonatal abstinence syndrome (NAS) and offers nonjudgmental support, education and counseling services to families and caregivers.

PDA Training

Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA) is offering training for Presbyterian Women to become disaster preparedness trainers. PW disaster preparedness trainers are expected to organize and conduct a minimum of three disaster preparedness trainings a year, sharing the basics of disaster preparedness with congregations in their presbyteries. The training will be held on Wednesday, August 1, 2018, 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM and is open to all interested PW. PDA will pay for two nights of lodging;

July 31 and August 1. All meals on August 1 will be provided.

AFTER YOU ARRIVE—HOUSING

Gathering Facilities

Gathering programming is being held at the Galt House (except for optional tours and the justice and peace march). A map of the Galt House will be in the program book, which you'll receive when you check in at Gathering registration. Here are a few tidbits to orient you to the Galt House (until you have your program book in hand):

- The Galt House has two towers—Rivue Tower (west) and Suite Tower (east).
- The towers are connected by a pedway, accessed on the third floor.
- Galt House check-ins and -outs are on the first floor of Suite Tower.
- Most sleeping rooms are in Rivue Tower.
- Meeting rooms will be in both Rivue and Suite Towers.
- Rivue Tower meeting rooms are named for flowers (second floor) or trees (third floor), except for Archibald, Cochran and Addition (to keep you on your toes)!
- Suite Tower meeting rooms are named for people, mostly Kentucky governors, for you history and crossword enthusiasts!

Finding Your Hotel from the Louisville Airport

There are a number of economical options for getting from the airport to your hotel.

- Reserve a shuttle through Xtreme Transportation. For pricing or to book, call 812/218-5600 (please note the new number since publication of the registration booklet!) or email galthouseshuttle@xtremetrans portation.com. (You may book your return to the airport at the transportation desk in the lobby of the Galt House, or book it at the same time that you arrange your arrival shuttle.) The shuttle is \$15 one way and \$25 round trip. Private car service is available upon request; additional charges apply.
- Taxis will be available (or may be arranged) at the airport. The

- approximate cost for a taxi from the airport to the Galt House is \$28 for up to four people.
- Lyft and Uber services are widely available. The approximate cost for these services from the airport to the Galt House is \$13 for up to four people.

Galt House Vouchers

If you reserved a room at the Galt House, make sure that the names of all occupants are on the room reservation. Every person staying at the Galt House will receive three \$5 vouchers, good toward the purchase of food and non-alcoholic beverages at the Galt House. These vouchers will be with your Gathering registration materials.

Hotel Finances

To avoid duplicate or mixed charges, check hotel bills the night before checkout, then again at checkout. Work with your

roommate and the front desk to be sure bills are accurate—i.e., charges are billed to the appropriate roommate and that no additional credit card charges appear. Keep a copy of your receipt to check against your credit card statement.

Parking

If you drive to Louisville or rent a car upon arrival, don't forget to budget money for parking your car. Parking rates at the Galt House for Galt House overnight guests are \$10 per day for self parking or \$28 per day for valet parking, both subject to change. If you do not plan to stay at the Galt House, rates are higher.

Helpful Tip

PW suggests that a \$2 per person tip be left each morning for hotel housekeeping services. Women provide most of these helpful services and often work for minimal wages.

AFTER YOU ARRIVE—PROGRAMMING

Gathering Check-in and Registration

Gathering check-in is separate from hotel check-in, even if you stay at the Galt House.

Go to the second floor of the Suite Tower in the Galt House to check-in or register onsite for the Gathering. This is where you will pick up your name tag, program book and other event registration materials.

Gathering registration will be open 11 AM–6 PM on Thursday, August 2, and Friday, August 3; and 11 AM–5 PM on Saturday, August 4.

Bring your gift cards, scrapbook page(s) and silent auction donation(s) when you register. You'll drop off the gift cards at registration; then go just around the corner to drop off your scrapbook pages and silent auction donations! contacted by the end of May.

Gathering Extras Pick-up

If you ordered a Gathering tote bag or a PW-logo water bottle, tickets for these items will be included with the materials you receive at Gathering registration.

If you registered before May 1, you will receive a ticket for a limited-edition Gathering pin.

If you were one of the first 800 to register, you will receive a ticket for a free copy of *Bound Together* in Love.


Take these tickets out of your registration materials and turn them in at the designated area at Gathering check-in/registration.

Business Meeting

The 2018 Business Meeting will be held just before the Gathering. More than 200 voting representatives from across the country will receive reports from the 2015–2018 triennium, adopt the 2018–2021 national budget, elect new PW, Inc., board members, meet and hear greetings from PC(USA) and

ecumenical partners and more. The Business Meeting is open to all observers and will be held in the Archibald Room (Rivue Tower, third floor) Wednesday, August 1, 7–9 PM and Thursday, August 2, 9 AM–5 PM. Business Meeting highlights will be published at www.presbyterianwomen.org/gathering.

Volunteers

Volunteers should check in at the Gathering registration desk. Volunteer check-in will be open 11 AM–6 PM on Thursday, August 2, and Friday, August 3; and 11 AM–5 PM on Saturday, August 4.

Thank you for volunteering to serve Communion! Those selected to serve Communion will be contacted by the end of June.

Taking the Tours

If you're registered for Mission Tour A (Thursday, August 2) or B (Friday, August 3), transportation has been arranged. Gather in the lobby of the Galt House Suite Tower at 12:50 PM to ride the bus.

If you're registered for a tour of the Presbyterian Center, budget 15–20 minutes to walk from the Galt House to the Center and sign in. Wait at the Washington Street security desk in the lobby.

Stepping Out for Justice and Peace March

The theme for the Stepping Out for Justice and Peace March on August 3 is "Ninth Street Divide," addressing segregation and racism in Louisville, Kentucky, and around the country. Ninth Street marks a de facto division between the east, predominantly white, part of Louisville and the west, predominantly African American, part of Louisville. A number of programs and practices (redlining, urban renewal, blockbusting) contributed to and maintained racial segregation and income inequality between the

east and west sides of town. This march with local and national leaders will give voice to concerns of residents who continue to endure discrimination and income inequality.

The march will leave from the Galt House's Rivue lobby. If you are in a workshop until 4:45, you will want to head directly to the west lobby. Wear comfortable shoes and bring your water bottle! Route maps will be provided. Make a placard ahead of time or pick up one on site. The march will take approximately 90 minutes from gathering time (4:45 PM) to return (6:15 PM). The march will leave the Galt House promptly at 5 PM and will pause briefly at Ninth and again at the Muhammad Ali Center (approximately 6 PM). Dinner is on your own that evening, so plan accordingly. Route maps will suggest places to eat near the route.

on Saturday. All sales benefit the Mission Pledge, PW's annual fund.


Ship It!
