#### SYNOD OF THE COVENANT

Presbytery of Cincinnati Contact Center Health Care Empowerment Project \$15,000

www.contactcentercincinnati.com

The Contact Center has an overall mission to organize low- and moderate-income people to work for positive social change. This project focuses on training women to be key advocates for beneficial Medicaid policies in Ohio. The Thank Offering grant will support monthly meetings to organize and train 20 to 30 women leaders.

#### SYNOD OF LAKES AND PRAIRES

Presbytery of South Dakota All About U Adoptions, Inc. Nevaeh House: A little piece of heaven \$50,000 www.aauadoptions.org

All About U Adoptions works with expectant mothers who struggle to secure housing due to lack of proper identification, poor credit, no positive rental history and lack of income. The Thank Offering grant will help purchase a home to provide welcoming, safe and healthy transitional housing for expectant mothers as well as counseling and adoption planning.

#### SYNOD OF LIVING WATERS

Mid-Kentucky Presbytery Lifehouse Maternity Home Kitchen Renovation \$27,000 www.lifehouselouisville.org

The residents of Lifehouse often arrive with little understanding of cooking or how their own food choices affect their unborn children. This grant will help expand a kitchen to allow space for hands-on cooking classes, daily meal preparation and lessons on essential nutrition, thus improving the mothers' health and further equipping them for independent living.

#### SYNOD OF MID-ATLANTIC

National Capital Presbytery Crossroads Community Food Network Community Kitchen Enhancements \$25,000

www.crossroadscommunityfoodnetwork.org

This community kitchen is a haven for local food production and education. Women who are eager to start a food business receive one-on-one technical assistance, affordable rental space and support to grow their endeavors. This project will expand and enhance the kitchen for primarily low-income and immigrant entrepreneurs.

#### SYNOD OF MID-ATLANTIC

Presbytery of Western North Carolina Faith 4 Justice Trauma-informed Ministry \$20,000 www.faith4justiceasheville.org

Faith 4 Justice is a bridge between local faith leaders and Black and Latinx community leaders who are committed to racial equity and healing through monthly meetings, trauma-informed materials and discussions led by those directly impacted by racism. The Thank Offering grant will support training for leadership development, community organizing and raising public awareness.

#### SYNOD OF THE NORTHEAST

Presbytery of Geneva Family Promise of Wayne County, N.Y., Inc. Day Resource Center Renovations \$22,500 http://fpwayne.org

Through community-based efforts, Family Promise helps families affected by homelessness to gain employment and sustainable housing. Local congregations shelter clients in church buildings, provide meals and assist with social services. This grant will help renovate a building for use as a day resource center and emergency overnight facility.

#### SYNOD OF THE PACIFIC

Presbytery of Nevada Northern Nevada Dream Center Reach the Hungry \$25,000 https://nndreamcenter.org

With the purchase of a 14-foot box truck, the Thank Offering grant will help provide healthy meals to individuals and families by bringing food directly to outlying localities and neighborhoods where food pantries are not available. By serving these communities more efficiently, Reach the Hungry can increase the number of persons served.

#### SYNOD OF SOUTH ATLANTIC

Presbytery of Tampa Bay Cedarkirk Camp and Conference Center Setting a Place for All \$27,000 https://cedarkirk.org/

Cedarkirk is working to provide more accessible facilities to older adults and people with disabilities. This grant will help construct a fully accessible dining facility, build a new welcome center and administration space, add an additional cottage to increase adult accommodations, and repurpose the current dining hall for new meeting space.

#### SYNOD OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA AND HAWAII

Presbytery of the Pacific Critical Mass Dance Company (CMDC) Dance Empowerment Programs \$12,500 www.criticalmassdancecompany.org

Since 2010, CDMC has taught Dance from the Heart, a traumainformed, free-form movement practice to over 1,500 low-income girls and women. This form of healing movement helps people get "unstuck" and travel forward in their lives with greater grace, ease, joy and support. This grant will support training events for local dance teachers to learn how to utilize Dance from the Heart with their own students.

#### SYNOD OF THE SOUTHWEST

Presbytery of Santa Fe Catholic Charities in the Archdiocese of Santa Fe Team Refugee Youth \$9,000 www.ccasfnm.org

In Albuquerque, many recently resettled refugee middle and high school students experience poor school attendance and academic performance. This grant will help build programs that provide learning helps for refugee youth and equip parents to guide and advocate for their children.

#### SYNOD OF THE SUN

Cimarron Presbytery Stillwater Domestic Violence Services, Inc. Shelter the Children \$5,000 https://wingsofhopeok.com

This grant will support a new initiative to reduce adverse childhood experiences related to violence seen by children in Oklahoma. Art and sports programs will be provided free to children living in the shelter while their moms are looking for work or dealing with legal issues.

#### SYNOD OF THE SUN

Presbytery of Arkansas Ferncliff Camp and Conference Center Transportation for Disaster Kits \$30,000 https://ferncliff.org

Many churches make disaster kits for Presbyterian Disaster Assistance but there are no collection depots in 12 southern states. Ferncliff is expanding the program by finding churches to serve as depots. The Thank Offering grant will be used to purchase a truck for picking up disaster kits from these new depots in the south, thus helping eliminate shipping costs, raise visibility and grow this hands-on mission program.

#### SYNOD OF THE TRINITY

The Presbytery of Donegal Domestic Violence Center of Chester County Community Healing Circle \$5,000 www.dvcccpa.org

First-person storytelling should be at the forefront of any healing process. Community healing circles provide a safe space for those impacted by domestic violence to share their stories, hear the group's collective wisdom, learn to take control of their narratives, and rewrite their own stories. The grant will support facilitator and childcare fees as well as healing circle supplies.

#### International

#### DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Association of Presbyterian Women of Kinshasa—West Synod Complete the Women's Centre and Training of Women \$14.813

The Women's Centre in Kinshasa has a goal to enhance the training of women so they can learn to assess local needs, find substantial solutions, and help transform churches and presbyteries of their synod. The Thank Offering grant will provide for the completion of this ongoing building project and offer a place for women to gather and receive leadership training.

#### **ETHIOPIA**

Gidada Theological College Construction of Girls' Dormitory \$43,650

Gidada Theological College recognizes that educating women is key to development for the whole society. Their goal is to strengthen the quality of their education programs for everyone by increasing the number of women students. Thank Offering funds will be used for the construction of a dormitory for female theological students in Dembi-Dollo.





#### In your PW group

#### In your church

  - o Get session approval.
  - o Make the Thank Offering annoucement during worship and ask givers to put money in a basket specificaly for the offering or give online at www.presbyterianwomen.org/give.
  - o Use the Thank Offering bulletin cover for worship and include the Thank Offering bulletin insert.
  - o Include an announcement in your church newsletter about the Thank Offering and how it helps change lives. Use an example from this booklet.
  - o Display the Thank Offering poster in a prominent place.
  - o Hold a special event, like a Thanksgiving meal, where you receive the offering. Use Thank Offering poster/placemats at the tables.

In February 2020, the Creative Ministries Offering Committee of Presbyterian Women met to review applications for Thank Offering grants. Fifteen of the projects were chosen for funding.
