There's Still Time To Give to the 2020 Thank Offering

One of this year's Thank Offering recipients, the Domestic Violence Center of Chester County, offers healing circles to bring together survivors, loved ones, advocates and anvone whose life has been impacted by domestic violence.

With journals and refreshments in hand, the group opens with meditation and a reflection on what they hope to gain from the experience. Then they have a story-sharing workshop to engage empowering and challenging questions and reflect openly with one another. They discuss times of feeling completely safe, who they can always count on, and their shared experiences around domestic violence. To close, they share their personal understandings of hope, support, safety and comfort,



which helps them reflect on how far they have come. In these circles, laughter echoes, tears freely flow and a real sense of community grows. "I've been going to therapy for 11 years," one participant in the circle said. "This was better."

Sermon ideas for pastors

WITH SUGGESTIONS FOR LEADERS BY DEE KOZA

- Help those you lead in worship to connect with scripture as a source of comfort, guidance, and hope during these difficult days.
- Into the Light can help you explore texts that are infrequently included in the Lectionary and ones you might not have preached, such as Job, Lamentations, and Hosea.
- In your sermons, give examples of ways that lament is not unique to today's problems but has been part of the story of the faithful since Creation.
- Into the Light includes contemporary songs, art, personal stories, and hymns that can be used as powerful sermon illustrations.
- The final lesson of *Into the Light* reflects on the "new heaven and a new earth" imagery from Revelation 22:1 that gives us hope for today and tomorrow. Use your sermons to reflect this hope we have in God whom we trust.



Matthew 25:35-36

In 2021, on Celebrate the Gifts of Women Sunday, we are invited to honor women who work for transformative change and seek to end poverty and injustice. Though Celebrate the Gifts of Women Sunday is March 7, 2021, your congregation or women's groups may use this resource on any day you choose.

ur ancestors in the faith include many bold women who disrupted systemic poverty. Mary, the Mother of our God, sang out and proclaimed God who overturns the bonds of poverty, as did Hannah before her. The lesser known five daughters of Zelophehad—Malah, Noah, Hoglah, Milcah, and Tirzah—negotiated with Moses for release from the destiny of poverty. Tabitha (Dorcas) witnessed to and worked for others' freedom from poverty. Each of these women in her own way recognized and challenged the *status quo* of wealth and power.* These stories document that women disrupting systemic poverty is not a new thing. As we celebrate women who disrupt systemic poverty, we reflect on our own work, too. Every day we stand before the throne of God, the one who disrupts the tangles of the world with the kindom.

The Celebrate the Gifts of Women resource, written by Jennifer Lord, includes a worship service with:

- a gathering prayer, call to confession, confession of sin, an assurance of pardon, suggested hymns and songs and scripture readings,
- sermon starter, and
- a litany for women who disrupt systemic poverty.
