





# Thank Offering 2021

Eliza Clokey of Springfield, Ohio, planted the seed for the Thank Offering in 1888 when she urged each woman to give one dollar over and above her usual contribution to the Women's General Missionary Society of the United Presbyterian Church of North America. Since then, faithful givers have responded to Eliza's call to give a "thank offering to her Lord." Over the last 33 years, Presbyterian Women has granted nearly \$27 million to more than 1,600 different projects at home and around the world through the PW Thank Offering.

In 2021 the Creative Ministries Offering Committee of Presbyterian Women reviewed 29 Thank Offering applications and selected 12 projects for funding. Nine of the projects serve people in the United States and three are international. In keeping with the Thank Offering bylaws, more than 40 percent of the selected projects are related to health ministries.



The more engaging the atmosphere is for children, the more comfortable they feel in sharing their stories and beginning the process of recovery and healing.

Koinonia Ministries has a mission to train and equip childcare workers to proclaim the love of God to new generations. In Belize, a single parent earns \$75 to \$90 per week but they must pay \$35 per week for childcare. The Thank Offering grant will help complete a new building for a Sunday school that serves 125 children per week and a cost-free day care center that serves 50 children of single parents.

This will increase reading literacy and educational success for mostly indigenous children living in areas where schools do not have books and resources. The program will also provide professional development opportunities for teachers across Guatemala, and will help build local leadership, facilitate onsite programs, and grow new teaching and learning sites.

The CCAP Synod of Zambia has many trained pastors but very few are women. Additionally, 12 of the synod's 15 presbyteries are in rural areas where subsistence farming is the primary means of survival. The college has plans to train 24 female farmers each year, as well as increasing female pastoral students from one to five. The Thank Offering grant will help build a women's hostel since current housing is available only to male students. The college administration hopes that with the new accommodations, more women will seek training, become leaders and help support fellow women, communities and families.

#### Meditation


In these verses from the book of Proverbs, we encounter wisdom personified as a woman who was active in creation and continues to instruct, guide, and proclaim God’s activity in the world. Much like a street preacher, Woman Wisdom cries out at the city gates and in the doorways of homes, teaching us that righteousness and faithfulness is a treasure to be sought. As she might say, being right with God and our neighbor is an important part of the way of wisdom.

When I reflect on Woman Wisdom from Proverbs, I can’t help but think about the wise women who have taught me to seek God, to share with others, and to learn from my forebears in the faith. I am overwhelmed with gratitude for these lessons that have made me the person I am today.

I remember my grandmother, an active church leader, treasurer, member of Pastor Nominating Committees, and PW Honorary Life Member. I have a collection of Bibles with her name written inside. These are not pristine, gift Bibles. They are dog-eared, used Bibles that demonstrate she took very seriously her study of scriptures and her life as a woman of faith.

I remember the Presbyterian Women of Second Presbyterian Church in Little Rock, Arkansas. I was new to the congregation, but that didn’t matter. When I got married at the church and had a baby two years later, they showered me and my family with parties, gifts, meals, and love. These PWs lived out their commitment to generous hospitality to old-timers and newcomers alike.

I remember the Women of the Church at the Presbyterian Church of the Covenant in Elizabeth, Indiana. This group began every circle meeting by singing old songs from hymnals their mothers and grandmothers had used. Inevitably, a familiar and cherished tune would be accompanied by a story about the woman who had sung it. This circle revered their ancestors and kept their memories as a blessing.



Woman Wisdom ends this lesson by declaring the joys of those who find her, saying that those who find her, find life and favor from the Lord. May we all seek and find wisdom in all her forms and at all her gates.

One: We rejoice in the prophetic word spoken by Anna who shows us that a Savior is near who will redeem the world.

All: **Happy are those who keep her ways.**

One: We rejoice in the strength of Prisca who shows us how to lead the church through service to others.

All: **Happy are those who keep her ways.**

One: We rejoice in the generosity of Mary who shows us that giving an expensive gift of perfume can demonstrate hospitality and devotion.

All: **Happy are those who keep her ways.**

One: We rejoice in the commitment, bold witness, and grace shown to us by women we find in scripture.  
May we listen, learn, and be made wise through them.  
All: **Happy are those who keep her ways.**

Gracious God, we give you thanks for providing for our every need: food, shelter, wisdom, skill, friendship, affection. We remember that these gifts come from you and are meant to be shared. 


