Board Summary, February 2022

Presbyterian Women Inc.'s Board returned to Zoom on February 24 and 25 for their second meeting of the 2021–2024 triennium. Moderator Kathy Reeves and Vice Moderator Kathleen Keefer facilitated the meeting, which was held for six hours over two days. During this time, the national Board reconnected with each other, heard presentations, welcomed leaders speaking to PW and denominational programs, voted several actions and thanked Board members completing their term with this meeting.

Representatives from Presbyterian Women's Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) Advisory Group joined the meeting. To support PW's commitment to antiracism, this group will provide focused attention on short- and long-term strategies that impact structural racism, including education/training, culture, policy, procedure, participation and leader recruitment. Chair of PW's 2024 Churchwide Gathering Jeanette Huie also joined the meeting on February 25 to talk about the event and receive input on the Gathering theme and scripture.

Hunter Farrell and Balajiedlang Khyllep, authors of Freeing Congregational Mission: A Practical Vision for Companionship, Cultural Humility and Co-Development (Downers Grove, IL: InterVarsity, 2022) presented ideas from their book. In a combination of stories and images, the coauthors led conversations about goals and realities of mission work, as well as how to approach and represent mission in a spirit of true partnership.

Kathleen Keefer delivered the second presentation, "Stopping Violence Against Women and Children." In keeping with the Board's emphasis this triennium on how they can help end violence against women and children, the presentation focused on actionable ways PW can promote support and healing for those who experience violence, as well as to promote programs that help create safe relationships.

In addition to approving minutes from the September 2021 Board meeting and approving the Personnel Committee's revisions to PW Inc.'s Personnel Handbook, Presbyterian Women's national Board acted on recommendations from a number of national committees.

Adopting the Cross-Agency Antiracism Policy

PW, Inc.'s Board adopted this antiracism policy that was created by the Diverse Voices Table and the executives of each
