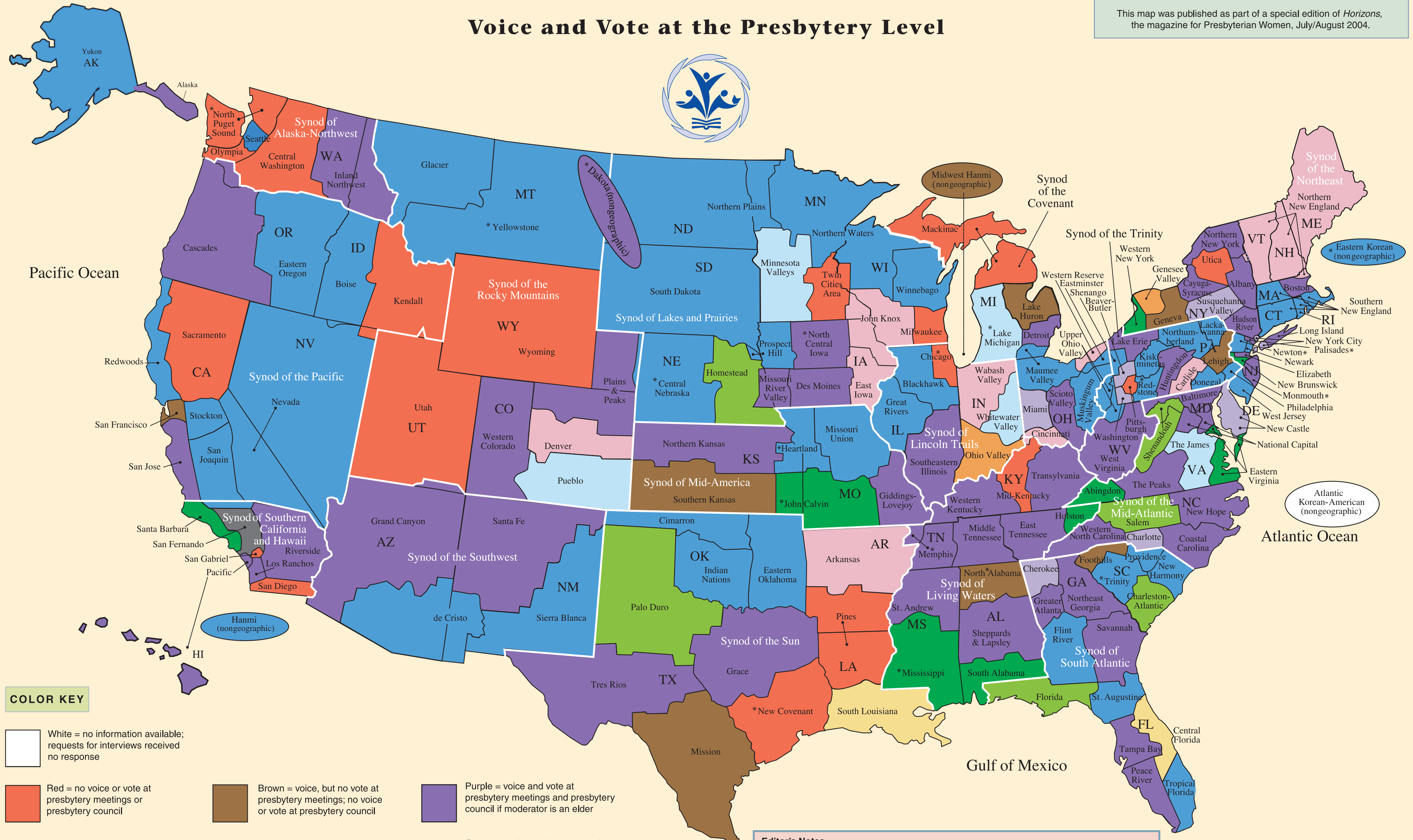

Voice and Vote at the Presbytery Level

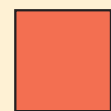

no response



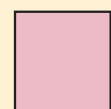
Red = no voice or vote at

only at presbytery council



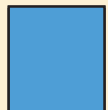
Gray = no voice or vote at
presbytery meetings; voice
and vote at presbytery council,
if moderator is an elder



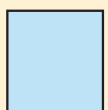
Pink = voice and vote at
presbytery meetings if moderator
is an elder; no voice or vote at
presbytery council



Brown = voice, but no vote at
presbytery meetings; no voice
or vote at presbytery council



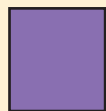
Blue = voice and vote at both
presbytery meetings and
presbytery council (no requirements)



Sky Blue = voice and vote
at presbytery meetings
(no requirements); no voice
or vote at presbytery council



Green = no voice or vote
at presbytery meetings; voice
and vote at presbytery council



Purple = voice and vote at
presbytery meetings and presbytery
council if moderator is an elder



Orange = voice and vote at presbytery
meetings if moderator is an elder;
voice only at presbytery council



Lime Green = voice but no vote
at presbytery meetings; voice
and vote at presbytery
council (no requirements)



Lavender = voice but no vote
at presbytery meetings and
presbytery council

3. Are there any requirements (such as she must be an elder or minister) that may prevent or allow the PW moderator to vote?
4. Is there anything else you think I should know related to this issue?
