PW, Inc., Board Summary, September 20–24, 2023



he PW, Inc., Board met September 20–24, 2023, at the Presbyterian Center in Louisville, Kentucky. The meeting began with new member orientation and closed with a business meeting and worship. The Board welcomed three new synod representatives, Anita Betts (Covenant), Alpha Brown (Northeast), and Angela Stephenson (Lincoln Trails) and young women representative, Mirna Wasef.

September 21–22, the Board and staff participated in a visioning session that loosely followed the methodologies of human-centered design. The session was facilitated by Michael Harper. Prior to the session, the participants conducted ethnographic research interviews. When together, the participants utilized their interview insights to create models of PW participants and potential participants and define the problem PW, Inc., faces before creating ideas for moving forward together.

A moderator appointed task group will review the findings and create actionable steps for the full board to consider and, if applicable, recommendations for the

voting representatives to the 2024 Triennial Business Meeting of Presbyterian Women.

In other work, **Board officers were elected**: Susan Jackson Dowd, president; Rhonda Martin, vice president and treasurer; April Davenport, vice president and secretary; Mike Kirk, assistant secretary. Officers are elected annually at the fall meeting.

PW, Inc.'s, financial position and annual audit were reviewed. Though revenues are down, particularly for the Annual Mission Fund, PW, Inc., remains in good financial standing with a clean audit. A triennial budget will be developed before the February/March meeting. The Board will review and approve the budget before sending it to the 2024 Triennial Business Meeting for adoption. The Board also reviewed the nomination slate for 2024–2027 national leadership. This slate appears in the November/December 2023 issue of *Horizons*. Nominees will be elected during the Business Meeting.

Let Justice Roll Down

God's Call to Care for Neighbors and All Creation

By Patricia K. Tull

With Suggestions for Leaders by Rebecca Barnes

Patricia Tull, author of the 2024–2025 PW/Horizons Bible study Let Justice Roll Down: God's Call to Care for Neighbors and All Creation, describes her call for creation justice in this way: "When I first learned of the climate crisis, I wondered how a biblical scholar with few practical skills could help and found my purpose in learning about ecology and teaching people of faith what I could. Such is not everyone's skillset or desire, but each of us has something to do with all our hearts."

We are called to care for neighbors and God's creation with all our hearts, with particular care for society's least powerful members who are disproportionately impacted by unjust systems. In God's first instructions to the nation of Israel we hear "you shall not pervert the justice due to the poor" (Exodus 23:6); in Moses' final speech at the promised land's border, he reiterated, "Justice, and only justice, you shall pursue" (Deuteronomy 16:20); and from Amos, the earliest recorded prophet, "Let justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an everflowing stream" (Amos 5:24). Scripture reminds us that we are called to speak out to urge our society to act for just transitions in this fast-changing world.

We invite you to join Presbyterian Women as we explore, with all our hearts, God's call to care for our neighbors and for creation. Readers will learn about ecological systems, the challenges we face in this time of accelerated climate change, and the possibilities available to address or counter the impact of human-made stress on our environment. Further, readers will explore theological questions that point us to act and engage, in small and large ways.
