

Over the last century, these grants have funded more than 200 major projects that continue to provide medical care, education, shelter, food, and support for people most in need at home and abroad. PW honors this legacy by celebrating women's giving today and looking towards the future. By providing grants to projects like Bethel Hills and Café Gingko, Presbyterian Women continues to faithfully serve our neighbors, support inclusive communities and witness to the promise of God's never-ending work in the world.

Advocates for Community Choice dba Bethel Hills Villa 5 Apartments and Recreation Area Marthasville, Missouri Bethelhills.org \$123,500

Many adults with intellectual/developmental disabilities (I/DD) experience difficulties finding appropriate and affordable housing and often struggle to make friends and thrive in the wider community. Many are placed in nursing homes, boarding homes, with aging parents or in other environments that are expensive and isolating. Bethel Hills addresses the unique needs of individuals with I/DD by providing a safe and loving place that takes into consideration their physical, emotional and spiritual needs in an environment where they can flourish.

By renovating a villa into four accessible apartments for eight individuals, this project will provide housing that takes into consideration specific needs unique to the residents, such as addressing acute sensitivity to sounds, bright light and certain colors. The new recreational area will offer space for art and music therapy and other leisure activities for people with and without intellectual/developmental disabilities. With the Birthday Offering grant, Bethel Hills will expand its mission to provide supportive, faith-based, inclusive community where all are accepted and valued.





Shawnee Presbyterian Church Café Gingko Louisville, Kentucky facebook.com/louisvilleshawneepresbyterian \$150,000

Shawnee Presbyterian Church serves as a welcoming beacon of light for their community in Louisville. Located in an economically disadvantaged area where single mothers and children face challenges of food insecurity, the church started addressing this need in August 2019. The small yet dedicated congregation began serving free dine-in meals at Café Gingko, named for a ginkgo tree located at the building's north entrance. On average, 30 meals were served at Café Gingko each Monday. In 2020, the pandemic put a stop to the program.

At present, the need for healthy food and fellowship continues to grow. With the Birthday Offering grant, Café Gingko will be able to reopen with a renovated kitchen and expanded capacity to provide meals. Improvements to the fellowship hall will allow the church to offer enriching activities: tutoring for elementary ages, Gingko Play Zone, financial literacy classes and Mama-to-Mama parenting workshops. The members of Shawnee Presbyterian Church will reach out and serve their beloved community with resilience and strength—just like the ginkgo tree outside their door.

Meditation

In this reading from Genesis, we encounter Israel's family as it is facing a turning point. Jacob, the leader of the clan, has died. Joseph, his brothers and the members of his household have all gone to Canaan to bury Jacob as he had requested. The brothers are concerned. While their father was still alive Joseph had forgiven them and treated them kindly. But now that their father is gone, would Joseph change his mind? Would he hold a grudge against his brothers and pay them back for the cruelty they had shown him when they were all younger?

We all have fears that plague us. Worries and concerns can preoccupy our thoughts. That is just natural. Where we turn for our hope and security is crucial. Joseph's brothers knew full well that even though years had passed, Joseph would be justified in holding them accountable for the injustice that they had shown him. They knew that they deserved punishment. However, when Joseph heard his brothers' concerns, instead of retaliating, he quickly offered them comfort: "Do not be afraid! Am I in the place of God? Even though you intended to do harm to me, God intended it for good, in order to preserve a numerous people, as he is doing today. So have no fear; I myself will provide for you and your little ones.' In this way he reassured them, speaking kindly to them" (Gen. 50:19-21).

We never know how God will use us to help another. Having a safety net brings hope and provides a sense of security. Gifts that you make to the Presbyterian Women Birthday Offering help alleviate the fears and insecurity that many of the most vulnerable experience each day. This year's grants fund two programs that will ensure safety and stability through new housing, fellowship, meals and other kinds of support for people in need.

The grant for Bethel Hills will help provide supportive housing along with social and recreational opportunities for adults with intellectual/developmental disabilities.

Here they can live, learn and worship together. This unique living option fills a serious gap in care for adults with disabilities and provides a community where all are valued, and every person is respected and acknowledged as a child of God.

The grant for Café Gingko will renovate the kitchen and fellowship hall at Shawnee Presbyterian Church in Louisville so members can provide a nutritious Monday meal to help mothers and their children at the start of the week. The refurbished space will serve as an outreach center to this under-resourced community by sponsoring activities and ongoing programs such as tutoring and organized play for children, and workshops on financial literacy and parenting for adults.

Prayer of Dedication

Protector God, you are ever mindful of the needs of your children. You have called your people together and shown us the way to care for each other. By your grace help all who find refuge at Bethel Hills and Shawnee Presbyterian Church to live in peace and unity within these households of faith. May they be encouraged to grow in your spirit and to seek your will. May the gifts we receive this day bring peace and comfort to their lives. Amen.
