Board of Directors September Meeting Summary



The PW, Inc. Board meeting in Louisville included time to visit Café Gingko a Birthday Offering grant recipient.

Work, Worship and Warmth

PW, Inc.'s First Board Meeting of the 2024-2027 Triennium

he recently-elected Stated Clerk of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) Rev. Jihyun Oh welcomed Presbyterian Women's Board to Louisville, Kentucky, for their first meeting of the triennium, held September 19–22, 2024, led by newly elected Moderator Pam Snyder and Vice Moderator Kelsey Law.

As the meeting opened on Friday, September 19, Jihyun reflected on changes happening in the church and world. She noted that while in the U.S. at large women's rights are being rolled back, in the PC(USA), women have been elected to a number of top leadership roles. Jihyun is the first woman elected to serve as Stated Clerk, following Bronwell Boswell who was the first woman to serve in the position as acting Stated Clerk. She reflected on how opportunities for women have changed over decades following advocacy and individuals being willing to break the glass- and stained-glass ceilings. Describing how change is vital yet at times uncomfortable, Jihyun laughingly referenced a video she'd seen recently of penguins on a cliff. In need of food, the penguins must jump from the 50-foot cliff into the water. Some penguins jump, seemingly without hesitancy, gracefully diving and transitioning to the water from the land. Other penguins topple and slide at the top of the cliff, falling awkwardly into the water. While we can't always control how or when change happens, she affirmed we can choose to embrace change and move forward in faith.

After a quick orientation to their responsibilities as board officers and training in parliamentary procedure, PW, Inc.'s Board got down to business quickly. They approved a new structure for working committees and task groups for PW at the churchwide level, streamlining the number of committees from 20 to 11. The standing committees, listed in the bylaws remain now Finance, Administration, and Search. The Personnel Committee is a required subcommittee of Administration.

PW Staff News: Patricia Longfellow Retiring

PW's senior administrative assistant Patricia Longfellow graduated to her retirement on October 31. Patricia served Presbyterian Women for 20 years and 25 days, diligently answering phone calls and emails from Presbyterian women throughout the PC(USA) and helping PW, Inc. meetings and programs run smoothly. Those who have talked with Patricia surely know she loves learning, connecting and traveling—so the human resources description of retirement as "graduation to retirement" is perfect for her!

Patricia's two decades (and 25 days) with PW has included thousands of emails and calls and letters, innumerable database updates, six PW Churchwide Gatherings (and one PW Online Gathering Event in 2021), and one Commission on the Status of Women. She staffed registration for the Gathering, and her enthusiasm for the Gathering (and support of those registering) helped bring new attendees to these triennial events. During her tenure with PW, Patricia even taught herself Spanish! Patricia's gifts are manifold, and her gift of kindness and appreciation are unparalleled.

Of her time with Presbyterian Women, Patricia said "My 20 years with PW has been a great ride. I've met some of the most amazing women around the country who have helped teach me how to grow older. Churchwide Gatherings were always a highlight so I could meet folks in person. Next year will find me on the road to St. Louis (which I love!), Montreal, and England if all goes well. Thank you to all PW for being so kind to me over the years."

Please join in the prayers of gratitude for Patricia's years with PW—especially notable because she had, she confessed, been a rolling stone for most of her career but chose to put down deep roots in PW.

The working committees, determined by the Board, are now Communications Coordination and Publishing, Bible Study, *Horizons* Editorial Advisory, Creative Ministries, Emerging Ministries, Racial Equity, and Stewardship Advisory. Emerging Ministries will look at new ways of being Presbyterian Women in the current and future church and social landscape from a mission, justice and peace and inclusive community perspective.

For the second full day of meetings, the PW, Inc. Board started the day with greetings from Rev. Dr. Diane Moffett, president and executive director of the Presbyterian Mission Agency. "Presbyterian Women is the backbone of the church," she said simply and enthusiastically. Following an overview of how the PW Purpose is lived out at the Churchwide level, the Board moved into committee meetings. The Board concluded the day with a visit to Café Gingko, one of the recipients of the 2024 Birthday Offering. Over delicious dinner and dessert prepared by Presbyterian Women from Shawnee Presbyterian Church, which houses Café Gingko, the Board had time for fellowship and then a tour of the kitchen that is being remodeled with funds from the Birthday Offering.

On the final morning of the meeting, the Board received reports from the various committees. Many Board members shared their experiences from the Churchwide Gathering, reflecting on the importance of making good financial decisions for the organization while also preserving spaces for community, connection and relationship-building. They voted in favor of a cost analysis and feasibility study for a PW Churchwide Gathering in 2027. The Board also approved a cost-of-living increase for staff and funds to make possible a yearend financial appeal. After finishing the business of the meeting, they watched a Gathering wrap-up video (available at presbyterianwomen.org/2024cwg). Reflecting on the first Board meeting of the triennium, a number of women spoke to various aspects of how and why Presbyterian Women organizes at all levels of the church. The Search Committee representative for the Northeast and Boriquen Bisi Shofu said "How wonderful it is to be surrounded by brilliant women." Synod Representative for the South Atlantic Betsy Berry celebrated the continuation of the legacy of almost 200 years of Presbyterian women organizing for mission. Sonia Minerva Pérez, Synod Representative for Boriquen, expressed her appreciation for the way the Board operates as a mix of "work. commitment and love."
