Ways to Give Giving through Your Group

Traditionally, PWs make commitments (or pledges) to the Annual Mission Fund in their church groups and their leader informs the presbytery treasurer of the commitment. In this model, participants in Presbyterian Women fund all levels of their organization through gifts received by PW in the congregations. In turn, a portion goes to the PW in the presbytery, then synod, and finally, churchwide (national). The commitments made in one year are honored with gifts made the next year.

Giving as an Individual

There are many reasons to give directly to PW Churchwide! Some Presbyterian women choose to give beyond what they pledge or give in their groups. Others participate in groups where giving isn't emphasized. Still others don't have an active PW group nearby. And many choose to support PW during life celebrations or in response to a particular campaign.
