Opening

Today you join the tens of thousands of faithful Presbyterian women (and men) honored for their service. Your light, like theirs, shines, allowing all to "see your good works and

give glory" to God (Matt. 5:16).

The Honorary Life

Membership pin
symbolizes values held
dear by Presbyterian
Women. The caring,
supportive hands
represent those who seek
to build an inclusive, caring

community. The leaf represents personal growth and our corporate response to Jesus Christ, nurtured in faith. The dove indicates our work for peace in our own lives and throughout the world, shown in the globe. At the center of the design is the cross, by which our sins are forgiven and we are freed to live in Christ—who is at the center of our lives. The overall design is of a butterfly, a symbol of newness in Christ. [The presenter may affix the pin (or utilizing the loop option on the back of HLM pins, bestow as a pendant with a cord) and the recipient may respond.]

Prayer of Thanksgiving

All: God of all times and places, we thank you for making us in your image, creating us to live together in your love and peace. We praise you for implanting in the heart of <name of honoree> the hope and vision of a caring community, a people of faith working together to pursue justice, show mercy and extend love. We thank you for <name of honoree>'s gifts, abilities and commitment. We ask your continued blessing on <name of honoree>, who has shown strength and patience, wisdom and love. We pray that we may hear what you are calling us to do in this time and in this place. Lead us, O God, to be diligent in prayer, enthusiastic in learning and steadfast in service. Through us, make real your community in Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

All: In gratitude to God, empowered by the Spirit, we strive to serve Christ in our daily tasks and to live holy and joyful lives, even as we watch for God's new heaven and new earth praying, "Come, Lord Jesus!"²

Tips for Groups Presenting Honorary Life Memberships



A Presbyterian Women Honorary Life Membership may be given to someone who was previously honored. Both gold and silver pins are available.

A person may be honored for any significant service to the church or PW in the Congregation, Presbytery, Synod or Churchwide.



The honor is not limited to women; any individual may be honored. The HLM pin is also a pendant. Consider providing the recipient with a cord or chain for that option.
