Q: What is the theme that guides 2025 PW Gives Day?

A: Legacy in Motion: Celebrating Our History, Trusting Our Future As we consider all we have done and are doing as Presbyterian Women, let us rejoice that our beloved organization is relevant, active and strong, and that thousands of our siblings in Christ live out the PW Purpose in faithful ministry every day. Q: I'd like to contribute to PW Gives Day! How do I do it?


- A: The key to a successful celebration is participation! PW Gives Day invites you to:

Petsy's Punch

Petsy Thacker—a PW participant from Indiana and recipient of an Honorary Life Membership, self-professed "river rat" and square dancer extraordinaire—is also skilled in punch making. "Petsy's Punch" is a frequent treat at the many celebrations and ministry outreaches of PW at First Presbyterian Church of Jeffersonville, Indiana. Even people who profess punch disinterest look forward to Petsy's punch!

Petsy chooses the color of her punch to "match" the season or celebration.

- For an orange punch (perfect for fall), combine two 64-ounce bottles of orange Hi-C and a quart of orange sherbet.
- For fruit punch (summer theme), Petsy combines two 64-ounce bottles of Hi-C fruit punch and ½ gallon of vanilla ice cream.
- For a delicious and light tropical punch (spring theme), combine 1 quart of pineapple sherbet and a two-liter bottle of 7Up.
