## Giving Through Your Group

Women make commitments to the Annual Mission Fund in their church groups and their leader informs the presbytery treasurer of the congregation's commitment. Presbyterian women pledge in 2025 for what they will give in 2026, and their pledges are received throughout 2026. In this model, Presbyterian women fund all levels of the organization through gifts received by PW in congregations, which, in turn, provides a portion to presbytery, then synod, and finally churchwide (national). Our blessings, combined and set in motion in this way, sustains our beloved PW. [idea! Groups can deepen their commitment by choosing PW as a recipient for an offering or rummage sale.]



# What is Presbyterian Women's Annual Mission Fund and why does it matter?

Put simply, PW's Annual Mission Fund is the operating fund for Presbyterian Women at all levels of the organization. With the Tree of Life imagery in mind, the Annual Mission Fund is the foundation the soil—that provides structure, strength and stability so that the tree's branches (PW) are sufficiently fortified to bear fruit, such as leadership development opportunities, denominational and ecumenical support, advocacy, Bible study, community and mission. Just as our names for particular trees vary regionally, historically and according to purpose, PW's Annual Mission Fund has also been known as the Contingency Fund, the Mission Pledge and the operating fund. Name changes aside, the Annual Mission Fund supports all the branches of PW work and witness in the world, growing from our PW Purpose.

### PW Purpose

- to nurture our faith through prayer and Bible study,
- to support the mission of the church worldwide,

This tree is PW "famous" as its resiliency and delicate beauty informed the name of the kitchen and community gathering place—Café Ginkgo—that received a 2024 PW Birthday Offering for major kitchen renovations. The saints who carry on the work of Shawnee and Café Ginkgo are few but, like the tree that graces the street, they are resilient, strong, and firmly planted in their community and steadfast in doing God's work through their denominational home. Thanks to their efforts and support from PW at large, meals are being served for an underserved community, and like a branch that bears more than one fruit, the improvements also provide space for financial literacy and parenting workshops for adults as well as tutoring and a safe play area for children. Gifts to PW's Birthday Offering made this hope happen; but "quietly" gifts received for PW's Annual Mission Fund made it possible by providing the structure and foundation so that this work could move from hope to fulfilment.
